This half mile stretch of coast at Long Island Sound in New London, Connecticut, is an impressive array of on-site activities families enjoy, and the boardwalk is alive, showing a busy schedule of summer events that will wipe you back to simpler times. Don't balk at the cost of admission: \$17 on weekdays, \$23 on weekends for a carload of up to five people. It's a small price for access to play-all-day fun with views of the soothing, shimmering water and, in the distance, the New London Ledge Light: one of the prettiest lighthouses in New England. Keep in mind, too, that admission is free in the season, when a walk to the beach can still be energizing and rejuvenating. One thing is about the coast: You will never be bored at Ocean Beach Park. Swimming in floating water and building castles of sweet sand, of course, the beach's main attractions. But here is much more to inhabit families with children of all ages. As you enter the parking lot, you'll see towering Triple Waterslides and petite Kiddie Land attractions where tots love carousel, train and other nostalgic rides, and teens head straight to the scrambler. For a quick bite, head over to Denny's Sand Castle: a fine-only snack bar right on the sand. The indoor outdoor Sandbar Cafe is located on a high deck overlooking the magnificent beach scene: Request a rooftop table if you can (but guard your food carefully, or crisp gulls will have a freeload). The café cooks up a varied menu of apps, salads, sandwiches, and seafood entrees (try scallop and bacon pizza), and the full bar offers a line-up of frozen fudge and beer list that includes some Connecticut-brewed choices for tap. Ocean Beach Park is also home to Boardwalk Creamery, where you can treat children to carnival-style treats such as popcorn and cotton candy, although ice cream is, of course, their specialty. If you find you're still starving (and salty air will do,so!) when you leave the beach, New London is home to one of Connecticut's best lobster shacks: Captain Scott's Lobster Dock. Just 3 miles from Ocean Beach Park, it's your place for local favorites like clam fritters and hot buttered lobster rolls. First settled by English settlers in 1646 and chartered as a city in 1784, New London is a place to explore centuries of history sights such as the Custom House Maritime Museum and Fort Trumbull State Park, where you can tour 19th century fortifications and learn about Connecticut's military innovation.
